 - (ii) Formulate an analytical model specification and operationalize the pertinent variables (2 marks)
 - (iii) Evaluate the limitations that Miss Atieno's proposed research formulation may suffer (4 marks)

- c) Interpret the regression analysis result jointly presented by John and Miss Atieno (Table 1) fully (5 marks)
- d) Describe the sampling procedure implied by the comment by the professor and point out the inherent weaknesses in this sampling method. (5 marks)
