

QUESTION ONE

Read the Case Study below carefully and answer the questions that follow:

COMPLIANCE OF TENDER PROCEDURES

Tenders for the supply of various items for the National Youth Service have been cancelled for processing through the e-procurement platform.

Debarment and suspension of erring NYS contractors will send the right signals to other suppliers and this is an important tool for ensuring compliance with integrityobligations of government contractors performing procurement actions for the government

While suggesting a way forward for procurement reform through early harmonization and consolidation of guidance, particularly in context of ongoing developments under state government regulations as well as those expected under the public procurement and disposal Act 2005 of the central government in Kenya, the President reiterated his directive for state institutions to adopt the e-procurement system to enhance transparency in tendering. Institution heads who fail to implement the orders once contractors are debarred or suspended are held responsible

He said this was also in a bid to monitor and streamline issuance of government contracts. Institution heads who fail to implement the order will be held responsible. The process will be conducted via the different components of the integrated Financial Management Information System rolled out by the government in 2014.

As is typically the case with government regulations in Kenya, executive guidance on the subject originates from the Director-General, public procurement oversight authority (PPOA)
