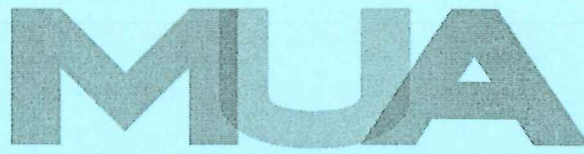

QUESTION ONE

- b) Examine the characteristics of centralized political systems in East Africa. Cite specific examples. (10marks)

QUESTION THREE

- a) Identify five Characteristics of the East African habitat during the pre-colonial period. (5marks)
- b) Citing examples, examine the pre-colonial modes of economic production in East Africa. (10marks)

QUESTION FOUR

- a) Outline the motives for the migration of East African communities. (5marks)
- b) Analyze the origin, migration and settlement of the Bantu speakers in East Africa. (10marks)

QUESTION FIVE

- a. Explain the common economic characteristics among the East African communities. (5marks)
- b. Examine the impact of the caravan trade to East African communities. (10marks)

QUESTION SIX

- a. Outline the challenges that Christian missionaries faced in East Africa. (5marks)
- b. Assess the role of Christian missionaries in the colonization of East Africa. (10marks)
