QUESTION ONE

Read the case study below carefully and answer questions that follow:

Man by nature is a social being. Through socializing man interacts with others in a way he may get solutions to some of the challenges he faces on earth. Human beings socialize in different ways; some of these are learning institutions, at work, play, political organizations and in the family.

Religion, however, plays a major role as an agent of socialization. In the 19th Century, three social theorists Max Weber, Karl Max and Emile Durkheim were the founding thinkers of modern sociology. Emile Durkheim, a French Sociologist (1858 – 1917) is however, generally considered the first sociologist to analyze religion in its social impact. It is from this that the study of the discipline sociology of religion emerged.
