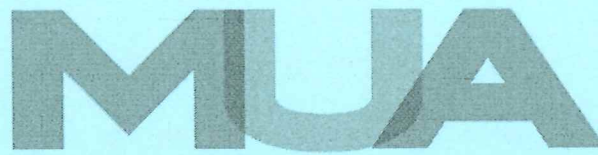

Read the Case Study below carefully and answer the questions that follow:

Jean Piaget spent his life to studying the sequences in the child's development of language and thought and came up with a comprehensive theory on intellectual development whose four stages have been the most discussed in the psychology of intellectual development and lay the foundation of curriculum development because of their elaboration of the sequences at each stage and what teachers should expect at each stage.

The four stages are generally accepted to constitute the developmental milestones of language and thinking and give approximate age and characteristics at which a typical child has reached before the next stage is considered.
